**New Business**

- **Report from Mike (Delegate ) about WSC 2025** - Mike discussed some of the items that were approved including 2 new Traditions added to the Nar-Anon 36 Workbook, 28 motions were acted upon. Mike will be sending out a report to the region about the 2025 WSC.
- **Region Assembly changes proposed today and will be added to the June agenda for more discussion:**
  1. All motions to be voted on at assembly must be submitted to the RSC 45 days prior to Assembly.
  2. RSC must send motions out to all region Nar-Anon GSRs 30 days prior to the Assembly so GSRs can get their home group conscience.
  3. Nominations for Regional office positions are the only exception - they may be made at the assembly.
  4. GSRs are the only individuals allowed to be in discussion at the assembly.
